**Year 7, 8 & 9 Dance Trip – Formula 1 Rolex British Grand Prix, Silverstone – Saturday 18 July 2020
(PLEASE NOTE THIS IS THE DAY AFTER WE BREAK UP FOR SUMMER)**

We are organising a trip to perform at the **Formula 1 Rolex British Grand Prix, Silverstone** on **Saturday 18 July 2020**. This trip is led by Pro-Excel.

Students will be performing with 30 schools from the UK and USA with a total of 1300 students performing at one time. This trip is a valuable experience for students to work with professional choreographers, experience a live sporting event and performing to a crowd of 110,000 race fans.

Please take note your child MUST understand that they will be performing and therefore it is essential they only sign up to this event if they WANT to dance. They will be required to attend 4 rehearsals dates July 2020 (dates to be confirmed).

This trip is an optional excursion which students will be subject to a charge of **£107.00**.

This includes:

- Return transport to the event Saturday 18 July (approx. departure 7.30am and return time 5.00pm)
- Professional choreography x 4 rehearsals
- Costume for the performance
- Student entry to the F1 event (worth £50)
- Media experience – local & national newspapers, radio and TV
- Parents welcomed to watch final rehearsal

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and money for a programme or refreshments at the event.

There are 70 places available on this educational visit. If your child would like to attend the educational visit we would ask that you pay the **deposit of £50.00** on Wisepay by **Friday 4 October 2019**. The remaining instalments will need to be paid as follow:

Second payment £30.00 by 1 November 2019
Final payment £27.00 by 2 December 2019
