

TRANSITION SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS WITH SEND

SUMMER 2019



The SENCo will attend all scheduled transition visits of schools who have returned the pre-transition forms and identified students with SEND. The SENCo will meet all students and their class teachers to discuss the needs of all students who will be attending Hampton Gardens. The SENCo will then meet with the school's SENCo on the same day, if possible, to discuss the needs, strategies and provisions of individuals in more depth, and identify students who would benefit from the following packages of support (to be organised before **Move Up Day on 03/07/2019**). The SENCo may also wish to observe specific students and look at their classwork in order to support in order to contextualise their profile of needs.

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT DURING THE SUMMER BREAK

For all students on SEN Support and students with an EHCP

Welcome letter, weekly timetable (subject and class teacher), home learning timetable, class groupings, email address of Hampton Gardens and blank Pupil Passport (if not completed already) to be posted to the home address of student when available (usually week before end of term).

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

For targeted students on SEN Support

SENCo can attend the child's Year 6 Summer SEN Review at their Primary school.

Students are invited to a pre-Move Up Day visit as a small group (2-5 students) with a Support Staff member from current school to complete a scavenger hunt around the school and a Q&A in Achievement Support (our SEND area). Students with EHCPs are also invited to attend these small group sessions in replacement / addition to a 1:1 visit.

For all students with an EHCP

SENCo can attend the child's Year 6 Summer SEN Review at their Primary school.

Individual student to visit Hampton Gardens with Support Staff member from current school (during school day, approx. 1hr) to complete an interactive transition pack tailored to the individual needs of the student. Multiple visits can be arranged depending on need.

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR PARENTS

For targeted students on SEN Support and students with an EHCP

SENCo to visit Primary school (familiar setting) to meet with student and parent (current SENCo/TA optional) to create Pupil Passport and discuss provisions for September.

OR

Individual student to visit Hampton Gardens with parents afterschool to create Pupil Passport and discuss provisions in Achievement Support (our SEND area). Parents and students are invited to our Summer SEN Reviews to see how the review process operates in Secondary school.
